CoQ 2012 Primary Care Program Overview

Please review the following Collaboration on Quality® (CoQ) 2012 Primary Care Program components.

CLINICAL SUITES

The following clinical suites and measures are based on National Quality Forum (NQF) approved measures or other nationally recognized quality measures. Each clinical suite includes a potential 2012 award for each performance level, which is determined by the percentage of Wellmark members under your care who meet that particular measure. Although the 2012 CoQ Program award amounts for each level are the same as the CoQ 2011 Program amounts, some of the percentages required to meet a certain level are different.

Child/Adolescent Wellness, Prevention, and Detection (Children turning 2 years or 3 to 17 years old during 2012)

Children turning 2 years old in 2012 who receive 4 DtaP, 3 IPV, 1 MMR, 4 HIB, 3 HEP-B, 1 VZV, and 4 pneumococcal conjugate vaccines on or before their second birthday	80%	85%	90%
Body mass percentile for those ages 3–17 years of age (annual)	80%	85%	90%

EFFICIENCY SUITE

The generic prescribing measure, a measure that relates to cost efficiency metrics, is identical to the 2011 measure. The data-sharing component, Total Cost of Quality Care, is not included in the 2012 CoQ program.
