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## Reporting Encounter Data for Medicaid Claims

**Background:** States that contract with Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) to deliver Medicaid services typically require those MCOs to report encounter data to the state. The national provider identifier (NPI) and national drug codes (NDC) are key data elements required for encounter data reporting. Below are the procedure/Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) codes and revenue codes that should be submitted with the associated NDC.

Note: For institutional or facility UB claims, submit the NDC in Loop 2410 LIN03 on electronic 837 claim submissions, or Form Locator 43 (Revenue Description) on paper. For professional claims, indicate the NDC in Loop 2410 LIN03 of the electronic 837 submission, or Item Number 24 shaded portion.
